Governance Council Meeting  
September 21, 2001

The Mat-Su Governance Council held its first meeting at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, September 21. In attendance were Jeanne Borega, Gail Johnston, Andrea Laughlin-Gaiser, Dan Mielke, and Will Miles. The committee discusses three items:

- 1) The committee recommended increasing the student worker hours for the Math and Business Departments from 16 to 20 hours per week on the condition that the department coordinators provide a letter to the Director including a justification for the increase, as well as the student workers description of duties, and schedule.
  
- 2) The committee discussed and supported a recommendation by Will Miles (Assistant Director of Academic Affairs) that all academic classes be held on campus unless required facilities are not available.
  
- 3) The committee discussed the listing of brokered Art and Music classes in the schedule, and in the interest of equal opportunity for all Art/Music lesson vendors, made the following recommendation: *Private lesson vendors will not be listed in the course schedule, but a sentence will be added which states: Private lessons are available through Mat-Su College; please call the college for a list of available instructors.*
